We hope you will join us as we celebrate forty years of learning and camaraderie. Happy 40th Birthday, CAPCA!

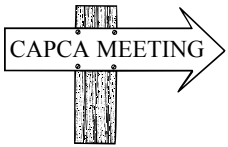
